Ignis	Wick (2)	Further network expansion of existing 3.5MW biomass woodfuel (woodchip) district heating scheme in Wick (Highland) to facilitate connection of Caithness General Hospital and additional 100 households.	£400,000
John Rennie	Wester Fintray	A small (70kW) off-gas biomass woodfuel (woodchip) district heating scheme providing heating to three households, including a farmhouse in Kintore (Inverurie). The new system will save on fuel bills (around 50%) for the householders, who are currently using mixture of oil and electric storage.	£53,000
Colin Clarke	Camaghael	A small (190kW) off-gas biomass woodfuel (woodchip) district heating scheme providing heating to 10 households and a church manse in Banavie (Ft William). Fuel bill savings will be in the region of 25%.	£145,000
Finnian Munro	Foulis	A medium Sized (400kW) off-gas biomass woodfuel (woodchip) district heating scheme providing heating to 10 households and a grain drying building in Evanton (north of Inverness). Householder fuel bill savings will be in the region of 40%	£257,000
Highland Wood Energy	Strathallan	A medium sized (800kW) off-gas biomass woodfuel (woodchip) district heating scheme connecting up 11 buildings in a school campus estate (Strathallan school) in Strathallan (Perthshire). Fuel bill savings in the region of 30%.	£320,000

Michael Paterson	Balgray Estate	A small off gas (150kW) biomass woodfuel (woodchip) district heating scheme providing heating to 3 households in Balgray (Lockerbie). Fuel bill savings in the region of 30%	£131,000
Forest Homes	Piperdam	A medium sized off gas (500kW) biomass woodfuel (woodchip) district heating scheme providing heat to 36 detached (owner occupier) households in Piperdam (near Dundee). Fuel bill savings in the region of 40%	£400,000
Fintry Dev. Trust	Balgair	A small off gas (190kW) biomass woodfuel (woodchip) district heating scheme, connecting 26 households and a community hall in Balgair (near Stirling). Fuel bill savings in the region of 25%.	£300,000
Farmstar Polska	Stevenson Steading	A small off gas biomass woodfuel (pellet) district heating scheme connecting two tenanted cottages, a farmhouse and administration block in Haddington (East Lothian). Households will save around 50% on heating costs.	£112,000
